## City officials celebrate grand opening of Marshfield Plaza

Daley; and Arturo Sneider and Leandro Tyberg, founding partners of Primestor Development, Inc., celebrate the grand opening of the Marshfield Plaza retail development at 119th Street and Marshfield Avenue in Morgan Park on June 5. The development, built on land formerly occupied by a Libby Foods canning plant, is anchored by Target, Jewel/Osco, Petco and Marshall's and also features L.A. Fitness, Burlington Coat Factory, Chili's and a variety of other restaurants and businesses. The development was heralded as a major breakthrough for big-box development on the South Side of Chicago, an area that Daley referred to as a "retail desert." The ribbon-cutting ceremony was also attended by 19th Ward Ald. Ginger Rugai, former state Senate Pres. Emil Jones, Sr., 21st Ward Ald. Howard Brookins, and Cook County Assessor Democratic candidate Joseph Berrios.
